AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR NATIVE AMERICAN INDEPENDENT LIVING
CENTERS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION.--Two hundred fifty thousand
dollars (\$250,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the
vocational rehabilitation division of the public education
department for expenditure in fiscal year 2009 for independent
living centers with sites in the Pueblo of Laguna and the
Pueblo of San Felipe to support disabled Native Americans. The
centers will provide services to individuals with disabilities
in the Pueblos of Acoma, Laguna, Isleta, Sandia, Santa Ana, San
Felipe, Santo Domingo, Cochiti, Zia and Jemez. Any unexpended
or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year
2009 shall revert to the general fund.
