House Memorial 25 requests the declaration of Friday, January 25, 2008 as "Gallup -McKinley Day" at the New Mexico House of Representatives.

### FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

- House Memorial 25 Provides the following statements:
- The city of Gallup and McKinley county are the northwestern gateway to New Mexico; and
- The city of Gallup and McKinley county reflect the rich cultural, recreational and economic diversity of New Mexico; and
- The city of Gallup is the home of the Gallup national historic district; and
- The city of Gallup is a center of commerce for the members of the Navajo Nation and has been a corridor for cross-country rail traffic since the nineteenth century; and
- McKinley county has the greatest number of Native American residents of any New Mexico county and is the home of many of the members of the Navajo Nation and the Pueblo of Zuni who reside in New Mexico; and
- McKinley county is the home of Red Rock state park and Red Rock museum and of one of the largest gatherings of Native Americans, the annual intertribal Indian ceremonial; and
- McKinley county incorporates the Continental Divide, which separates the watersheds of the Pacific and Atlantic oceans
