AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR CAVERNOUS ANGIOMA CLINICAL CARE,
RESEARCH AND TEACHING AT THE UNIVERSITY OF NEW MEXICO.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION.--Three hundred seventy-five thousand dollars (\$375,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the board of regents of the university of New Mexico for expenditure in fiscal year 2010 for the health sciences center to establish a center for excellence and a site for a national angioma organization to study cavernous angioma by focusing on clinical care through early diagnosis and access to genetic testing and counseling; on research by seeking ways to decrease hemorrhage or lesion growth; and on teaching by helping primary care providers, emergency room physicians and radiologists throughout the state to recognize cavernous

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1 angioma or familial cerebral cavernous malformations. Any
2 unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of
3 fiscal year 2010 shall revert to the general fund.

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
