14	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:
15	Section 1. Section 2-4-1 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1967,
16	Chapter 234, Section 1, as amended) is amended to read:
17	"2-4-1. COMMISSION FOR THE PROMOTION OF UNIFORMITY OF
18	LEGISLATION IN THE UNITED STATES
19	A. There is created a "commission for the promotion
20	of uniformity of legislation in the United States", <u>also known</u>
21	as the "uniform law commission". Its membership shall consist
22	of:
23	$[A_{\bullet}]$ (1) two members appointed by the New
24	Mexico legislative council, who shall be members of the
25	legislature;

1	(2) any member of the New Mexico bar who has
2	represented New Mexico as a member of the uniform law
3	commission for twenty or more years and who has been elected as
4	a life member of the uniform law commission;
5	[ <del>B.</del> ] <u>(3)</u> four members of the New Mexico bar,
6	who shall be appointed by the New Mexico legislative council;
7	[and who shall serve on the commission at their own expense;
8	$G_{\bullet}$ ] (4) the dean of the university of New
9	Mexico law school or [ <del>his</del> ] <u>the dean's</u> designee; and
10	$[\underline{\vartheta}$ .] (5) the director of the legislative
11	council service, who shall serve ex officio.
12	<u>B.</u> The members shall be known as [ <del>the</del>
13	"commissioners for the promotion of uniformity of legislation
14	in the United States"] "uniform law commissioners" whose
15	purpose is to promote uniformity of legislation in the United
16	<u>States</u> ."
