## **SUMMARY**

Synopsis of Bill

House bill 862 amends Section 56-8-30 NMSA 1978 relating to loan prepayment penalties. The bill adds loans on mobile homes, and other purchase contracts, as additional types of lending in which prepayment penalties are not enforceable. It also includes prepayment of an installment payment in addition to the current law which pertains to prepayment of the balance of the loan.

## FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

The responding agencies report there is no fiscal impact to state government.
