Synopsis of HEC Substitute

HEC Substitute of House Bill 929 amends Section 4-38-13.1 NMSA 1978 which relates permitted uses of county equipment and property. The bill provides for the exemption to the Procurement Code pursuant to Section 13-1-98.2 NMSA 1978, allowing a board of county commissioners to contract for the use of county buildings for the benefit of nonprofit organizations that have demonstrated a consistent history of service to sick and indigent persons in the county.

Lastly, its adds county buildings pursuant to Section 4-38-13.1 NMSA 1978 are exempted from the Procurement Code and do not apply to contracts entered into by a local public body with a person, firm organization, corporation, association or state educational institution named in Article 12, Section 11 of the Constitution of New Mexico.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

The bill does not contain an appropriation or carry a fiscal impact.
