## Synopsis of Bill

House Memorial 7 declares February 7, 2009 as "Northern New Mexico 'REDI' for Action Day" at the House of Representatives. REDI stands for "regional economic development initiative," a project that was initiated and funded by Los Alamos county in 2008. The purpose of the initiative is to develop an economic strategy and plan for north central New Mexico by targeting four industry clusters for development over five, ten, and twenty-five-year planning horizons.
