#### **SUMMARY**

### Synopsis of Bill

House Memorial 19 states that there is a need for accountability to the public for revenue collections and for a public repository in the form of a web site of all financial information collected by the state from tax returns. A study is to be conducted by the interim Revenue Stabilization and Tax Policy Committee to determine both the need for and feasibility of an Office of Fiscal Accountability. The purpose of this office would be to collect, compile and publish in electronic format monthly financial information on all revenues collected and distributed by the state, publish periodic reports summarizing revenue collection information and additional information from tax returns for use in determining trends for each of the State's revenues, and provide independent analysis of ways to improve the state's tax system.
