Synopsis of Bill

House Memorial 28 requests that the state Tourism Department designate the Carlsbad Chamber of Commerce as a welcome center for New Mexico's southeast region.

The reasons cited in support of this designation include Carlsbad offering vacation and recreation opportunities such as Carlsbad Caverns National Park, the Living Desert Zoo, Gardens State Park, its proximity to Guadalupe Mountains National Park, and Brantley Lake State Park. The bill further cites the city's celebration "Christmas on the Pecos" as a seasonal attraction to in-state and out of-state visitors.

The memorial further requires that a copy be sent to the Secretary of the Tourism Department.
