Thousands of veterans from around the country travel to Angel Fire to visit the memorial every year. This memorial would study the feasibility of developing a center where veterans can seek treatment for a variety of health issues in a peaceful setting. Currently, there is no center dedicated solely to treating veterans in a rural, peaceful area of the country. A center such as this may be an economic boost to the local economy of the Moreno Valley by attracting veterans from around the country.
