SUMMARY

Synopsis of Bill

SB 352 appropriates \$75,000 to fund a full-time clerk in the San Miguel County probate court. A clerk currently serves in the San Miguel County probate court, but funding for this position expires at the end of FY 09. SB 352 appropriates \$75,000 to fund the probate clerk through FY 10 and FY 11.

The probate clerk's duties are twofold:

1. Perform scheduling, process all incoming paperwork, including examining the paperwork for completeness.

2. clean up and reorganize the existing probate court files

The funds will also be used for travel, office supplies, and clerk training.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

SB appropriates \$75 thousand to fund a clerk in the San Miguel County probate court.

According to the December 2008 revenue estimate, FY10 recurring revenue will only support a base expenditure level that is \$293 million, or 2.6 percent, less than the FY09 appropriation. All appropriations outside of the general appropriation act will be viewed in this declining revenue context.

SIGNIFICANT ISSUES

As drafted, this bill appropriates \$75,000 to the Administrative Office of the Courts. The AOC does not distribute funding for the state probate courts. Funding should be appropriated to the local government division of the Department of Finance and Administration for the San Miguel County Probate Court.

WHAT WILL BE THE CONSEQUENCES OF NOT ENACTING THIS BILL

The San Miguel county probate court will not receive funding for a clerk.
