SUMMARY

Synopsis of Bill

Senate Judiciary Committee Substitute for Senate Bill 482 amends Section 31-20-5.1 NMSA 1978, which deals with payment of probation costs for those convicted of DWI, driving on a suspended license, or any misdemeanor under the Criminal Code. The bill changes the imposed probation fees of \$15.00 to \$30.00 to \$15.00 to \$50.00.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

This bill would potentially increase revenue for local county entities to operate misdemeanor compliance programs but would not increase state general fund revenues.
