#### **SUMMARY**

#### Synopsis of Bill

Senate Bill 496, Alamo Senior Center Operations, appropriates \$100 thousand from the general fund to ALTSD for the purpose of funding operational expenses at a senior center in Alamo in Socorro County.

### FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

The appropriation of \$100 thousand contained in this bill is a recurring expense to the general fund. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 2010 shall revert to the general fund.

### Senate Bill 496 – Page 2

The LFC submitted a balanced general fund appropriation recommendation for fiscal year 2010. Any additional general fund expenditures appropriated by the Legislature must be off-set by an equal amount from the appropriation recommendation.

According to the December 2008 revenue estimate, FY10 recurring revenue will only support a base expenditure level that is \$293 million, or 2.6 percent, less than the FY09 appropriation. All appropriations outside of the general appropriation act will be viewed in this declining revenue context.

### **SIGNIFICANT ISSUES**

This appropriation would augment operations at the Alamo Senior Center which is operated in the Navajo Area Agency Aging Network service area; however, the request was not submitted to the Navajo Area Agency Aging Network nor prioritized accordingly.

# WHAT WILL BE THE CONSEQUENCES OF NOT ENACTING THIS BILL

The operations of the senior center will be funded out of distributions from the Navajo Area Agency Aging Network.
