The purpose of the organization is to perpetuate the memory of all the men and women who have served in the country’s armed forces, to be patriotic, to foster true democracy, to care for the unsupported mothers who gave their children to the service of the nation, to uphold the American institutions of freedom, justice and equal rights, and to defend the United States from all enemies.
