An unintended outcome of the memorial might be to encourage English Language only or discrimination based on national origin or immigration status.

Respect for the flag may raise issues regarding previous lawsuits brought by the American Civil Liberties Union. The rights of students as United States citizens should be examined.

ADMINISTRATIVE IMPLICATIONS

The Secretary of PED may need to distribute information on Americanism topics and respect for the flag to districts within the state.
