# **SUMMARY**

### Synopsis of Bill

Senate Memorial 67 requests that the Insurance Division of the Public Regulation Commission (PRC) study the potential benefits of mileage-based vehicle insurance to the residents of New Mexico.

The study shall include recommendations on the feasibility of implementing mileage-based vehicle insurance policies in New Mexico through regulation without the need for additional legislation and recommend any other steps necessary to implement mileage-based insurance.

The study shall be presented to the appropriate interim Legislative Committee by November 1, 2009 and a copy submitted to the library of the Legislative Council Service.

#### FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

The memorial has no appropriation; however, implementing the directives contained in this bill may have a minimal administrative impact including staff time and appropriate supporting resources.
