Senate Memorial 88 requests the interagency behavioral health purchasing collaborative convene a team of appropriate stakeholders to discuss a plan for the sustainability of the New Mexico screening, brief intervention and referral to treatment (SBIRT) program in integrated primary care and school-based health clinics.
