AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL OUTLAY; REVERTING BALANCES OF CERTAIN  
GENERAL FUND APPROPRIATIONS; TRANSFERRING BALANCES TO THE  
GENERAL FUND; AUTHORIZING CERTAIN SEVERANCE TAX BOND  
APPROPRIATIONS; PROVIDING FOR REVERSION OF CERTAIN BALANCES;  
DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. GENERAL FUND BALANCES REVERTED.--

Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, the  
unexpended balance up to the amount specified of the following  
appropriations shall not be expended and shall revert to the  
general fund pursuant to procedures, policies and deadlines  
established by the financial control division of the department  
of finance and administration:

1. four hundred thousand dollars (\$400,000) to the

3 vehicles for senior centers nationwide on the Navajo Nation in

7 Section 3 for renovations at armory facilities statewide;

8 3. four hundred thousand dollars (\$400,000) to the

10 111 of Laws 2006 to plan, design, construct, renovate and equip  
11 the department of public safety district office in Albuquerque  
12 in Bernalillo county;

13 4. ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) to the capital  
14 program fund in Subsection 2 of Section 35 of Chapter 92 of  
15 Laws 2008 to plan, design and construct a safety inspection  
16 station at the Santa Teresa port of entry in Santa Teresa in

19 two hundred thirty-nine dollars (\$1,499,239) originally  
20 appropriated to the capital program fund in Subsection 1 of

23 Section 112; and finally in Laws 2009, Chapter 128, Section 246  
24 to complete phase 2 construction and equip and install a  
25 platform static scale at the Santa Teresa port of entry in Dona

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1 Ana county and to design, construct, equip and furnish a  
2 building for the border authority at the Santa Teresa border  
3 crossing in Dona Ana county;

4 6. one hundred forty-six thousand nine hundred  
5 fifty-one dollars (\$146,951) of the original appropriation to  
6 the public education department in Subsection 442 of Section 55  
7 of Chapter 42 of Laws 2007, which was reauthorized and  
8 reappropriated to the capital program fund in Paragraph (1) of  
9 Subsection B of Section 210 of Chapter 83 of Laws 2008, to  
10 plan, design, construct, equip and furnish a safety inspection  
11 station in Santa Teresa in Dona Ana county;

12 7. one million one hundred thousand dollars  
13 (\$1,100,000) to the capital program fund in Subsection 12 of  
14 Section 64 of Chapter 111 of Laws 2006 to plan, design and  
15 construct a motor vehicles department field office in Santa Fe  
16 in Santa Fe county;

17 8. five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000) to the

17 Section 2. SEVERANCE TAX BONDS--AUTHORIZATIONS--  
18 APPROPRIATION OF PROCEEDS.--

19 A. The state board of finance may issue and sell  
20 severance tax bonds in compliance with the Severance Tax  
21 Bonding Act in an amount not to exceed the total of the amounts  
22 authorized for purposes specified in this act. The state board  
23 of finance shall schedule the issuance and sale of the bonds in  
24 the most expeditious and economical manner possible upon a  
25 finding by the board that the project has been developed

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1 sufficiently to justify the issuance and that the project can  
2 proceed to contract within a reasonable time. The state board  
3 of finance shall further take the appropriate steps necessary  
4 to comply with the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended.  
5 Proceeds from the sale of the bonds are appropriated for the  
6 purposes specified in this act.

7 B. The agencies named in this act shall certify to  
8 the state board of finance when the money from the proceeds of  
9 the severance tax bonds authorized in this section is needed  
10 for the purposes specified in the applicable section of this  
11 act. If an agency has not certified the need for the issuance  
12 of the bonds for a particular project, including projects that  
13 have been reauthorized, by the end of fiscal year 2011, the  
14 authorization for that project is void.

15 C. Before an agency may certify for the issuance of  
16 severance tax bonds, the project must be developed sufficiently  
17 so that the agency reasonably expects to:

18 (1) incur within six months after the  
19 applicable bonds have been issued a substantial binding  
20 obligation to a third party to expend at least five percent of  
21 the bond proceeds for the project; and

22 (2) spend at least eighty-five percent of the  
23 bond proceeds within three years after the applicable bonds  
24 have been issued.

25 D. Except as otherwise specifically provided by

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1 law:

2 (1) the unexpended balance from the proceeds  
3 of severance tax bonds issued pursuant to this act for a  
4 project shall revert to the severance tax bonding fund no later  
5 than the following dates:

6 (a) for a project for which severance  
7 tax bonds were issued to match federal grants, six months after  
8 completion of the project;

9 (b) for a project for which severance  
10 tax bonds were issued to purchase vehicles, including emergency  
11 vehicles and other vehicles that require special equipment;  
12 heavy equipment; books; educational technology; or other  
13 equipment or furniture that is not related to a more inclusive  
14 construction or renovation project, at the end of the fiscal  
15 year two years following the fiscal year in which the severance  
16 tax bonds were issued for the purchase; and

17 (c) for any other project for which  
18 severance tax bonds were issued, within six months of  
19 completion of the project, but no later than the end of fiscal  
20 year 2013; and

21 (2) all remaining balances from the proceeds  
22 of severance tax bonds issued for a project pursuant to this  
23 act shall revert to the severance tax bonding fund three months  
24 after the latest reversion date specified for that type of  
25 project in Paragraph (1) of this subsection.

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1           E. Except for appropriations to the capital program  
2 fund, money from severance tax bond proceeds provided pursuant  
3 to this act shall not be used to pay indirect project costs.

4           F. For the purpose of this section, "unexpended  
5 balance" means the remainder of an appropriation after  
6 reserving for unpaid costs and expenses covered by binding  
7 written obligations to third parties.

13 Section 4. PUBLIC SCHOOL CAPITAL OUTLAY FUND--TRANSFERS  
14 TO GENERAL FUND.--

15 A. Thirty-one million six hundred thousand dollars  
16 (\$31,600,000) is transferred from the public school capital  
17 outlay fund to the general fund for the purpose of meeting  
18 appropriations from the general fund. The money transferred  
19 represents the remaining portion of the amount of the general  
20 fund appropriation made in Laws 2006, Chapter 111, Section 66  
21 that has been allocated to school districts for the state share  
22 of projects pursuant to Section 22-24-5.7 NMSA 1978 but that  
23 has not yet been expended.

24 B. Twenty million dollars (\$20,000,000) is  
25 transferred from the public school capital outlay fund to the

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1 general fund for the purpose of meeting appropriations from the  
2 general fund. The money transferred represents the amount  
3 transferred from the general fund to the public school capital  
4 outlay fund in Subsection C of Section 12 of the General  
5 Appropriation Act of 2009.

6 Section 5. SEVERANCE TAX BOND APPROPRIATIONS TO THE  
7 PUBLIC SCHOOL CAPITAL OUTLAY FUND.--Pursuant to the provisions  
8 of Section 2 of this act, upon certification by the public  
9 school capital outlay council that the need exists for the  
10 issuance of the bonds, the following amounts are appropriated  
11 to the public school capital outlay fund for the following  
12 purposes, and any unexpended or unencumbered balance shall not  
13 revert:

14 A. thirty-one million six hundred thousand dollars  
15 (\$31,600,000) for the purpose of meeting allocations made in  
16 Laws 2006, Chapter 111, Section 66 to school districts for the  
17 state share of the projects pursuant to Section 22-24-5.7 NMSA  
18 1978; and

19 B. twenty million dollars (\$20,000,000) to carry  
20 out the purposes of the Public School Capital Outlay Act.

21 Section 6. EMERGENCY.--It is necessary for the public  
22 peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.
