A MEMORIAL

REQUESTING THE OFFICE OF THE ATTORNEY GENERAL TO STUDY THE
FEASIBILITY OF IMPLEMENTING A "COMMUNICATION PROTECTION
REGISTRY ACT".

WHEREAS, the residents of New Mexico are subject to
receiving inappropriate and unwanted messages through various
forms of electronic messaging systems; and

WHEREAS, the message preference system is a program to
protect residents from unwanted classes of electronic messages;
and

WHEREAS, a message preference system could be implemented
in New Mexico at no cost to the state; and

WHEREAS, residents could register, through an internet web
site, their email addresses, mobile phone numbers, instant
messenger identifications and other electronic contact points

1 as being off limits to certain classes of electronic messages;
2 and

3 WHEREAS, the registrants' information contained within a
4 message preference system database would remain confidential,
5 accessible only to authorized state agencies or third parties;
6 and

7 WHEREAS, at no time would any third party be able to use
8 information contained within a message preference system
9 database to contact a registrant for any reason; and

10 WHEREAS, security systems would be able to eliminate abuse
11 of a message preference system and ensure that the private
12 information of registrants is kept confidential; and

13 WHEREAS, it would be unlawful for a person to promote to a
14 registered electronic contact point the person's trade,
15 business goods, products, property or services sold; and

16 WHEREAS, a person that violates a provision of the
17 Communication Protection Registry Act could be assessed a civil
18 or criminal penalty by the attorney general;

19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE STATE
20 OF NEW MEXICO that the office of the attorney general be
21 requested to study the feasibility of implementing in New
22 Mexico a Communication Protection Registry Act; and

23 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the office of the attorney
24 general present the results of its study and any
25 recommendations for legislation to the appropriate interim
