Bill Summary:

HM 42 directs the Legislative Education Study Committee (LESC) to establish a work group to study and explore research that has proven to be effective in promoting the recruitment and training of high school students to pursue careers in education.

The memorial notes that the Legislature finds that local chapters of Future Educators Association (FEA) can be beneficial in the recruitment of better and more diverse students into the teaching field. In this regard, HM 42 further requests the LESC to develop a strategic plan for the recruitment and training of students, incorporating its findings and the research, in collaboration with:

- the Career and Technical Education Division of the Public Education Department;
- the New Mexico chapter FEA;
- colleges of education; and
- public school district directors and teachers of career and technical education.

Finally, HM 42 requests that the strategic plan be disseminated to superintendents and charter school administrators statewide.
