## AN ACT

RELATING TO FINANCIAL SOLVENCY; PROVIDING FLEXIBILITY TO SCHOOL DISTRICTS DURING PERIOD OF DECREASED FUNDING; SUSPENDING THE REQUIREMENTS FOR CERTAIN STUDENT ASSESSMENTS IN THE 2012-2013 SCHOOL YEAR.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

- SECTION 1. PUBLIC SCHOOL FINANCIAL SOLVENCY--TEMPORARILY SUSPENDING CERTAIN STUDENT ASSESSMENTS.--
- A. The purpose of this section is to provide flexibility to school districts during this period of decreased funding by suspending the requirements that school districts administer certain student assessments.
- B. For the 2012-2013 school year, the public education department and school districts, charter schools and state educational institutions shall not be required to

administer the following student assessments:

- (1) the provisions of Section 22-2C-4 NMSA 1978, notwithstanding the standards-based assessment in social studies in grade eleven; and
- (2) the provisions of Section 22-2C-4.1 NMSA 1978, notwithstanding a college placement assessment or a workforce readiness assessment in grade eleven.
- During the 2012-2013 school year, all public schools and state educational institutions shall use an appropriate assessment for grades nine and ten to comply with the federal Individuals with Disabilities Education Act.
