14	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:
15	SECTION 1. Section 4-37-3 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1975,
16	Chapter 312, Section 3, as amended) is amended to read:
17	"4-37-3. ENFORCING COUNTY ORDINANCESJURISDICTION
18	A. County ordinances may be enforced by prosecution
19	for violations of those ordinances in any court of competent
20	jurisdiction of the county or through an administrative hearing
21	process that affords due process to an individual who violates
22	those ordinances. Penalties for violations of any county
23	ordinances shall not exceed a fine of three hundred dollars
24	(\$300) or imprisonment for ninety days or both the fine and
25	imprisonment; except that a county may enact and enforce

1 ordinances that impose the following penalties in addition to any other penalty provided by law: 2 no more than one thousand dollars (\$1,000) 3 (1)for discarding or disposing of refuse, litter or garbage on 4 5 public or private property in any manner other than by disposing it in an authorized landfill; 6 7 (2) no more than five thousand dollars 8 (\$5,000) for the improper or illegal disposal of hazardous 9 materials or waste in any manner other than as provided for in the Hazardous Waste Act; and 10 (3) no more than imprisonment for three 11 12 hundred sixty-four days or a fine of one thousand dollars (\$1,000), or both, for violation of an ordinance regarding 13 14 driving while under the influence of intoxicating liquor or drugs. 15 Β. Prosecution of violations under this section may 16 be commenced by the issuance of a citation charging the 17 18 violation. Citations may be issued by the code enforcement 19 officer of the county or an employee [or employees] of the 20 county authorized by the board of county commissioners to issue such citations." 21 SECTION 2.
