SUMMARY

Synopsis of Bill

House Bill 74 removes the requirement that applications for absentee or absentee-early ballots in certain conservancy districts elections be notarized.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

There is no fiscal impact.

SIGNIFICANT ISSUES

This bill makes absentee ballot applications for conservancy districts meet the same standard as that set forth for absentee ballot applications under the Election Code.

This bill will make it easier for the voters in certain conservancy district to request applications for absentee or absentee-early ballots. Under this bill they will have to sign the application, but will not be required to have it notarized.
