[(4)] (5) complying with match or contribution requirements for the receipt of federal funds relating to criminal justice programs; and

[(5)] (6) no more than fifty percent of the replacement salaries of municipal and county law enforcement personnel of municipalities or counties rated as Class 1 in Paragraph (1) of Subsection [6] B of Section 29-13-4 NMSA 1978 participating in basic law enforcement training.

B. Amounts distributed from the fund shall be expended only pursuant to approved budgets and upon duly executed vouchers approved as required by law."
