11 RELATING TO MOTOR VEHICLES; CLARIFYING THE USE OF CERTAIN SPEED
12 LIMIT VIOLATIONS.

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14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

15 SECTION 1. Section 66-7-302.1 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1989,
16 Chapter 318, Section 30 and also Laws 1989, Chapter 319,
17 Section 8, as amended) is amended to read:

18 "66-7-302.1. SPEED LIMIT--CONVICTION--USE LIMITED.--

19 A. The division shall not use a violation [~~under~~
20 ~~Paragraph (3) or (4) of Subsection A~~] of Section 66-7-301 NMSA
21 1978, where the posted speed limit is designated as fifty-five
22 or sixty-five miles an hour, for the purpose of suspending or
23 revoking a driver's license unless the driver was exceeding the
24 speed of seventy-five miles an hour.

25 B. An insurer shall not consider a violation [~~under~~
