RELATING TO GAME AND FISH; AMENDING SECTION 17-3-13.7 NMSA 1978

(BEING LAWS 2011, CHAPTER 45, SECTION 1) TO PROVIDE FOR

NONRESIDENT DISABLED MILITARY MEMBERS AND VETERANS TO HUNT ORYX

AT THE RESIDENT FEE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

SECTION 1. Section 17-3-13.7 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 2011, Chapter 45, Section 1) is amended to read:

"17-3-13.7. NONRESIDENT DISABLED MILITARY MEMBERS AND VETERANS--HUNTING LICENSES AT RESIDENT FEE.--A nonresident disabled active duty member or veteran of the United States armed forces who is undergoing a rehabilitation program that involves hunting activities and that is sponsored by the federal government or a nonprofit organization authorized by the federal government and is under the direction of a military .191122.1
