applicable to state officers and agencies and state officers
and employees, except where otherwise specifically provided by
law.

C. There shall be [nineteen] <u>twenty</u> judges of the Bernalillo county metropolitan court."

SECTION 7. Section 35-1-10 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1968, Chapter 62, Section 12, as amended) is amended to read:

"35-1-10. MAGISTRATE COURT--DONA ANA DISTRICT.--There shall be [six] seven magistrates in Dona Ana magistrate district. Divisions 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, [and] 6 and 7 shall operate as a single court in Las Cruces and shall rotate riding circuit to Anthony and Hatch on a regularly scheduled basis."

SECTION 8. TEMPORARY PROVISION--DISTRICT AND METROPOLITAN JUDGES--APPOINTMENTS.--The additional district and metropolitan judgeships provided for in this act shall be filled by appointment by the governor pursuant to the provisions of Article 6 of the constitution of New Mexico.

SECTION 9. TEMPORARY PROVISION--MAGISTRATE--APPOINTMENT AND ELECTION.--The office of magistrate in Dona Ana district, division 7, shall be filled by appointment by the governor. The appointed magistrate shall begin serving on July 1, 2013 and shall serve until succeeded by a magistrate elected at the .190324.1SA
