11 RELATING TO ELECTIONS; REQUIRING BALLOTS TO ALLOW FOR STRAIGHT
12 PARTY TICKET VOTING; ALLOWING CROSSOVER VOTING.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

15 SECTION 1. A new section of Chapter 1, Article 10 NMSA
16 1978 is enacted to read:

17 "[NEW MATERIAL] BALLOTS--STRAIGHT PARTY VOTING OPTION.--

18 A. In a general election in which more than one
19 qualified political party is represented on the ballot, the
20 ballot shall be designed to allow the voter to vote for all of
21 a qualified party's slate of candidates on the ballot by
22 marking a single straight party option for that party's slate
23 of candidates.

24 B. The ballot shall provide the straight party
25 option for each qualified political party with candidates in

1 two or more statewide contests for state office.
2 Notwithstanding the provisions of Section 1-1-5.2 NMSA 1978,
3 when a voter selects the straight party option, a vote shall be
4 automatically cast for the candidate of the party chosen in
5 each partisan contest in which the party has a candidate and in
6 which the voter does not cast a vote for a different candidate
7 in that contest."
