11 MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR NEW MEXICO SENIOR CITIZEN PROGRAMS.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

14 SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION.--

15 A. The following amounts are appropriated from the
16 general fund to the aging and long-term services department for
17 expenditure in fiscal year 2014 for the following purposes:

18 (1) four million six hundred thirteen thousand
19 six hundred eighty-three dollars (\$4,613,683) for the six area
20 agencies that provide senior services, including adult daycare,
21 case management, congregate meals, home-delivered meals, in-
22 home services, transportation and senior center services;

23 (2) one hundred seventy thousand nine hundred
24 thirteen dollars (\$170,913) for volunteer programs, including
25 foster grandparents, senior companions and retired senior

1 volunteers; and

2 (3) one hundred twelve thousand forty dollars
3 (\$112,040) for senior health promotion activities, including
4 senior olympics.

5 B. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining
