CAPITAL PROJECTS FOR REPRESENTATIVE DONA G. IRWIN

I request that the following be funded:

- to the department of environment

LORDSBURG HOSPITAL SITE ASBESTOS ABATEMENT

one hundred twenty thousand dollars (\$120,000) to remove and dispose of asbestos contamination, including abatement in the old hospital building, at the hospital site in Lordsburg in Hidalgo county

BUTTERFIELD TRAIL REGIONAL LANDFILL CONSTRUCT

five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000) to plan, design, construct and equip a new lined solid waste cell at the Butterfield trail regional landfill in Deming in Luna county

- to the local government division of the department of finance and administration

LUNA CO REGIONAL LAW ENFORCEMENT COMPLEX CONSTRUCT

one million two hundred thousand dollars (\$1,200,000) to construct, renovate, equip and furnish a regional law enforcement complex in Luna county

- to the department of transportation

HIDALGO CO RD 001 CONSTRUCT

two million dollars (\$2,000,000) to plan, design, construct and pave county road 001 in Hidalgo county

HERMANAS GRADE RD & NEW FRONTIER RD CHIP SEAL

two million five hundred thousand dollars (\$2,500,000) to plan, design and construct improvements, including chip sealing, to gravel surfaces on Hermanas Grade road and New Frontier road in Luna county

HERMANAS GRADE ROAD LUNA CO IMPROVE

one million four hundred thousand dollars (\$1,400,000) to plan, design and construct improvements, including widening and resurfacing, to Hermanas Grade road in Luna county

COLUMBUS PARK STREET LIGHTS INSTALL

thirty-two thousand dollars (\$32,000) to plan, design, construct and install street lights near the community park in Columbus in Luna county

WNMU-DEMING LEARNING CENTER INFO TECH

four hundred thousand dollars (\$400,000) to purchase and install information technology, including related equipment, furniture and infrastructure, at the learning center facility of western New Mexico university in Deming in Luna county
