I request that the following be funded:

• to the public education department

PUBLIC SCHOOLS ROBOT EQUIPMENT

three hundred twenty thousand dollars (\$320,000) to purchase and install robot equipment and related infrastructure statewide for the public school robot education programs that participate in the annual robot competition in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county

• to the department of environment

BLOOMFIELD WATER LINES FOR IRRIGATION

seven hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$750,000) to design and construct water lines from the wastewater treatment plant to tie into irrigation lines north and south of New Mexico highway 64 in Bloomfield in San Juan county

KIRTLAND VALLEY ACRES WASTEWATER SYSTEM IMPROVE

three million five hundred thousand dollars (\$3,500,000) to design and construct improvements to the Valley Acres wastewater system in Kirtland in San Juan county
