**CAPITAL PROJECTS FOR SENATOR STEVEN P. NEVILLE**

I request that the following be funded:

- to the public education department

**PUBLIC SCHOOLS ROBOT EQUIPMENT**

three hundred twenty thousand dollars (\$320,000) to purchase and install robot equipment and related infrastructure statewide for the public school robot education programs that participate in the annual robot competition in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county

- to the department of environment

**BLOOMFIELD WATER LINES FOR IRRIGATION**

seven hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$750,000) to design and construct water lines from the wastewater treatment plant to tie into irrigation lines north and south of New Mexico highway 64 in Bloomfield in San Juan county

**KIRTLAND VALLEY ACRES WASTEWATER SYSTEM IMPROVE**

three million five hundred thousand dollars (\$3,500,000) to design and construct improvements to the Valley Acres wastewater system in Kirtland in San Juan county

- to the department of transportation

**EAST AZTEC ARTERIAL ROUTE CONSTRUCT**

ten million one hundred sixty-two thousand dollars (\$10,162,000) to construct the east Aztec arterial route to serve as the business route around the city's downtown district in Aztec in San Juan county

**PINON HILLS BLVD ROAD EXTENSION & BRIDGE**

nineteen million dollars (\$19,000,000) to plan, design and construct the Pinon Hills boulevard road extension and bridge across the Animas river in Farmington in San Juan county

### SJC SCHOOL OF ENERGY

five million dollars (\$5,000,000) to design, construct, furnish and equip, including erosion control improvements, the school of energy at San Juan college in Farmington in San Juan county

- to the board of regents of New Mexico state university

### NMSU ATHLETIC FACILITIES IMPROVE

seven hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$750,000) to plan, design, construct, renovate and equip improvements to athletic facilities, including installing artificial turf at Aggie memorial stadium, at New Mexico state university in Las Cruces in Dona Ana county

### NMSU SW CTR FOR RANGELAND SUSTAINABILITY IMPROVE

two hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000) to plan, design, construct, equip and furnish cabins and infrastructure improvements at the southwest center for rangeland sustainability of New Mexico state university in Torrance county
