AN ACT
RELATING TO ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT; CREATING THE FRONTIER
COMMUNITIES PROGRAM.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

SECTION 1. Section 3-60B-1 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1985,
Chapter 88, Section 1) is amended to read:

"3-60B-1. SHORT TITLE.--Chapter 3, Article 60B NMSA
1978 may be cited as the "Main Street Act"."

SECTION 2. Section 3-60B-4 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1985,
Chapter 88, Section 4, as amended) is amended to read:

"3-60B-4. MAIN STREET PROGRAM--CREATED--COORDINATOR--
POWERS AND DUTIES.--

A. There is created the "main street program" in
the economic development department. The secretary of
economic development shall employ a coordinator to oversee
the program.

B. The coordinator shall:

(1) carry out state responsibilities
pursuant to contract with the national main street center of
the national trust for historic preservation;

(2) coordinate activities of the program in
consultation with the historic preservation division of the
cultural affairs department;

(3) advise the New Mexico community

2 requests for proposals and selection of local government
3 grantees for the program to be funded through community
4 development block grants;

5 (4) monitor the progress of main street
6 projects;

7 (5) assist local main street project
8 managers;

9 (6) assist in the development of the
10 frontier communities program; and

11 (7) perform other duties necessary to carry
12 out the provisions of the Main Street Act." _____
