2	DECLARING MARCH 1, 2013 TO BE "HEALTH CARE ADVANCE DIRECTIVE

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5	WHEREAS, developments in health care technology make
6	possible many alternatives for treating medical conditions and
7	make possible the unnatural prolongation of life; and
8	WHEREAS, an adult should be spared unwanted health care
9	procedures; and
10	WHEREAS, a competent adult should have the clear legal
11	choice to accept or reject health care, even if rejecting
12	health care will result in death sooner than death would be
13	expected to occur through the provision of the rejected health
14	care; and
15	WHEREAS, advance care planning is the practice of making
16	explicit written instructions to caregivers, family and
17	friends on measures for delivering health care and for
18	preserving that adult's dignity in the event that the adult is
19	unable, because of incapacity, to make those instructions
20	known when needed at a later time; and
21	WHEREAS, advance care planning includes the use of
22	advance health care directives, health care powers of attorney
23	and medical orders for life-sustaining treatment that can be
24	administered effectively within the health care system; and
25	WHEREAS, advance care planning provides support for

SJM 8 Page l patients and their families making difficult life decisions; and

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WHEREAS, advance care planning ensures that the patient's informed end-of-life health care choices are known, documented and respected; and

WHEREAS, advance care planning provides competent adults with a legal tool to designate a health care agent and express preferences about health care options to go into effect only after the adult loses the ability to make or communicate health care decisions, including deeply personal decisions about end-of-life care;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO that the right of each adult to expect dignity and privacy be recognized; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the right of an adult to refuse to be treated with the adult's consent be protected; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the right of competent adults to make fully informed health care decisions expressed contemporaneously or through advance health care directives be recognized; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that March 1, 2013 be declared "Health Care Advance Directive Day" at the New Mexico legislature.\_\_\_\_\_

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
