2 DECLARING FEBRUARY 22, 2013 AS "GIFTED DAY" IN THE SENATE.

4 WHEREAS, the state of New Mexico has long realized the
5 merits of gifted education and has promoted gifted education
6 strategies from elementary school to the highest levels of
7 academia; and

8 WHEREAS, there are more than fourteen thousand gifted
9 students across New Mexico who are represented in all aspects
10 of New Mexico's rich cultural life; and

11 WHEREAS, New Mexico has long been a leader in science,
12 technology and research, which depend on creative and
13 high-achieving students; and

14 WHEREAS, New Mexico is a leading state in teaching and
15 respecting gifted students who also have learning or
16 emotional disabilities; and

17 WHEREAS, New Mexico is a state that celebrates gifted
18 students and their work in research, the arts and academia;
19 and

20 WHEREAS, organizations such as the New Mexico
21 association for the gifted and the Albuquerque association
22 for gifted and talented students promote gifted excellence;

23 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE
24 STATE OF NEW MEXICO that February 22, 2013 be declared
25 "Gifted Day" in the senate; and

1 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the senate recognize the
2 New Mexico association for the gifted and the Albuquerque
3 association for gifted and talented students for their
4 efforts in the service of gifted students and their families
5 and teachers; and

6 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this memorial be
7 transmitted to the New Mexico association for the gifted and
8 the Albuquerque association for gifted and talented students.==
