CELEBRATING THE IMPORTANT AND LASTING LEGACY OF JOE CISNEROS.

WHEREAS, Joe Cisneros is a native of Questa and was raised on a farm; and

WHEREAS, Joe has a deep understanding of and respect for the land and water in northern New Mexico; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Cisneros' legacy of activism dates back to the 1960s, when he alone protested the abuse of workers and the environment near his native Questa by a large mining corporation; and

WHEREAS, with little support from his fellow workers,

Joe stood up to the corporate leadership to address what he

considered unfair work policies and discrimination against

Hispanic workers; and

WHEREAS, after the mining corporation took action against him, Joe Cisneros exposed certain unfair practices that the corporation was using against employees, and soon thereafter, Joe was fired by the corporation; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Cisneros continues his activism in the community of Questa and has served on the Questa school board; and

WHEREAS, Joe, never one to back down from a fight against injustice, is known throughout his community as a battler for people that may be unable to fight for

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO that the important and lasting legacy of Joe Cisneros be celebrated; and
