

1 A MEMORIAL

2 DECLARING CONNELL'S CABIN IN THE VILLAGE OF TERRERO IN SAN
3 MIGUEL COUNTY TO BE A NEW MEXICO TREASURE.

5 WHEREAS, on August 8, 1990, the cultural properties
6 review committee voted to include Connell's cabin, located in
7 the village of Terrero in San Miguel county and overlooking
8 the Pecos river, in the state register of cultural properties
9 in recognition of its historic and cultural significance; and

10 WHEREAS, Connell's cabin was originally built and used
11 by the United States forest service from 1914 to 1917; and

12 WHEREAS, in 1925, the cabin was purchased by the
13 American metals company, which operated the historic Terrero
14 lead and zinc ore mine, and the cabin served as living
15 quarters for visiting executives during the mine's heyday;
16 and

17 WHEREAS, the cabin came into the ownership of
18 A. J. Connell, the original director of the Los Alamos ranch
19 school, which later became Los Alamos national laboratory and
20 the primary site for the World War II Manhattan project; and

21 WHEREAS, the cabin is now owned by Jay C. Anderson and
22 Thomas C. Larson, who both have a passion to restore and make
23 available this historic landmark for generations to come;

24 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE
25 STATE OF NEW MEXICO that the historic Connell's cabin be

1 declared a New Mexico treasure; and

2 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this memorial be
3 sent to the governor, the historic preservation division of
4 the cultural affairs department, Jay C. Anderson and
5 Thomas C. Larson.
