#### Synopsis of Bill

House Bill 152 expands the authorized uses of the law enforcement protection fund (LEPF) to include the purchase of law enforcement equipment including protective vests for police dogs.

This bill does not change the amount appropriated to local law enforcement agencies it simply expands the list of items local law enforcement agencies are authorized to use the LEPF for.
