## **SUMMARY**

#### Synopsis of Bill

House Bill 440 appropriates \$250 thousand from the general fund to the AODA for the purpose of increasing funding for children's advocacy programs.

#### FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

The appropriation of \$250 contained in this bill is a recurring expense to the general fund. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of FY14 shall revert to the general fund.

### **SIGNIFICANT ISSUES**

Without this appropriation, the AODA lacks funds in its operating budget that could be used for the Children's Safe House Network.
