SUMMARY

Synopsis of Bill

House Memorial 97 (HM 97) requests that the Public School Capital Outlay Council (PSCOC), Legislative Education Study Committee (LESC), the Legislative Finance Committee (LFC), the Public Education Department (PED), and the Department of Finance and Administration (DFA) establish a work group to examine the feasibility of including the Santa Fe Indian School in the public school capital outlay standards-based funding process. The memorial also requests that the work group report the results of its study to the legislature and the executive prior to the beginning of the 2014 legislative session.

SIGNIFICANT ISSUES

HM 97 states that the Santa Fe Indian School provides education to students from 7th through 12th grades that come from all 19 Indian pueblos within the state of New Mexico. However, the memorial notes that the school does not participate in the state's public school operational funding formula or the higher education funding process, and has no state project review process through which it can prioritize and justify its capital outlay needs.
