SUMMARY

Synopsis of Bill

The Senate Judiciary Committee substitute for Senate Bill 353 reconciles multiple amendments to Section 14-2-6 of the Inspection of Public Records Act enacted in 2011 by renumbering definitions in Section 1, adding a reference to Section 14-3-18 of the Public Records Act in Section 2D, and declaring an emergency so that the amendments would be effective immediately upon signature of the Governor.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

SB 353 would have no fiscal impact.

SIGNIFICANT ISSUES

The CPR states: "Section 1 amending the Inspection of Public Records Act is an important amendment that will grant the Compilation Commission authority to properly number the definition section of the Act."
