Synopsis of Bill

Senate Joint Memorial 40 supports the One Billion Rising Event, a call to men and women to refuse to participate in the status quo until rape and rape culture end, and recognizes February 14, 2013 as One Billion Rising V-Day in honor of the survivors of violence and sexual abuse.

SIGNIFICANT ISSUES

One Billion Rising is a campaign initiated by V-Day, a not-for-profit charity/activist movement to end violence against women and girls, promoting creative events to increase awareness and raise money. One in three women on the planet will be raped or beaten in her lifetime, translating to more than one billion of the world's population of seven billion.
