### SUMMARY

#### Synopsis of Bill

Senate Memorial 60 proclaims February 21, 2013 to be “St. Felix Pantry Day” at the Senate.

### SIGNIFICANT ISSUES

The memorial notes that, for over 20 years, the St. Felix pantry is a nonprofit charitable organization that provides food, clothing, household items and referral services free of charge to people in need. The memorial adds that New Mexico ranks 48<sup>th</sup> in the nation for poverty, and the need for the kinds of services offered by St. Felix pantry has grown in relationship to the recent economic downturn; they currently provide the equivalent of two million meals per year for more than 53 thousand households.
