Synopsis of Bill

Senate Memorial 37 recognizes Dr. George I. Sanchez for the distinguished service he gave to New Mexico in the field of education, and proclaims October 4, 2013 as “Dr. George I. Sanchez Day”.

SIGNIFICANT ISSUES

Dr. Sanchez, born in the Barelmas community of Albuquerque in 1906, dedicated his life to education by becoming a scholar, educator, activist, pioneer, and visionary in public education in New Mexico and Texas. Dr. Sanchez has ten schools in Texas and three schools in California named after him, but none in his home state.
