### SUMMARY

#### Synopsis of Bill

Senate Memorial 55 declares February 20, 2013 “Support the New Mexico Alliance of YMCAs Day”.

### SIGNIFICANT ISSUES

The bill notes that the NM state alliance of YMCAs has been strengthening the foundations of community through programs and services that foster youth development, healthy living and social responsibility for over 100 years. Over 28 thousand individuals benefit directly each year from the Y’s extensive programming for all ages and interest groups.

The bill adds that the YMCA is one of the largest volunteer-led and –driven organizations in New Mexico and has rewarded nearly \$240 thousand in financial aid so that everyone, regardless of ability to pay, could participate in the Y.
