Synopsis of Bill

Senate Memorial 86 encourages the Public Education Department (PED) to establish schoolwide positive behavior intervention support systems in public schools, as well as providing professional development to teachers and principals to optimally implement these systems in public schools.

SIGNIFICANT ISSUES

The memorial notes that one middle school in the state that implemented schoolwide positive behavior intervention support systems experienced a 50 percent reduction in office referrals over a three-year period and an increase by 50 percent of students who had a 3.5 or higher grade point average.
