Synopsis of Bill

Senate Memorial 87 asks the Public Education Department to study the feasibility of establishing a parent engagement office. The objective of the parent engagement office would be to: maximize the parental involvement efforts of public schools; collect data on parental involvement; review and monitor school district parental involvement policies and family engagement action and implementation plans; develop corrective action plans for public schools and school districts regarding family engagement; advise school districts on integrating activities that will encourage parental involvement in schools; and collect data about family involvement in each public school activity in order to determine which activities need more parental involvement.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

Assuming the PED can study the feasibility of establishing a parent engagement office within its FY 13 and FY 14 operating budgets, there will be no fiscal impact on the State.
