A MEMORIAL

REQUESTING THE GOVERNOR, THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION, THE
TOURISM DEPARTMENT AND THE NEW MEXICO CONGRESSIONAL DELEGATION
TO WORK TO ACHIEVE THE RE-DESIGNATION OF NEW MEXICO STATE
HIGHWAY 333 AS "HISTORIC UNITED STATES ROUTE 66".

WHEREAS, New Mexico state highway 333 is designated on

as having been a portion of the historical United States "Route
66"; and

WHEREAS, many visitors to New Mexico and other states
through which the historical United States "Route 66" passed

road" of the United States, yet find it difficult to locate;
and

WHEREAS, many New Mexico businesses and residents enjoy

2 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF
3 REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO that the governor,
4 the department of transportation, the tourism department and
5 the New Mexico congressional delegation be requested to work to
6 achieve the re-designation of New Mexico state highway 333 as
7 "Historic United States Route 66"; and

8 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this memorial be
9 transmitted to the governor, the secretary of transportation,
10 the secretary of tourism and the members of the New Mexico
11 congressional delegation.
