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10 A JOINT RESOLUTION

11 PROPOSING TO AMEND ARTICLE 12 OF THE CONSTITUTION OF NEW MEXICO
12 BY ADDING A NEW SECTION TO LIMIT CLASS SIZES IN PUBLIC SCHOOLS
13 BY THE 2020-2021 SCHOOL YEAR; ALLOWING WAIVERS UNDER CERTAIN
14 CONDITIONS PRIOR TO THE 2020-2021 SCHOOL YEAR.

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16 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

17 SECTION 1. It is proposed to amend Article 12 of the
18 constitution of New Mexico by adding a new section to read:

19 "A. The legislature shall make adequate provision
20 to ensure that by the beginning of the 2020-2021 school year,
21 there are sufficient numbers of classrooms and teachers so that
22 the maximum number of students who are assigned to each teacher
23 in a public school classroom does not exceed the following:

24 (1) for kindergarten through grade three,
25 eighteen students per class;

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1 (2) for grades four through eight, twenty-two
2 students per class; and

3 (3) for grades nine through twelve, twenty-
4 five students per class.

5 B. The class size requirements of Subsection A of
6 this section do not apply to music, band, elective or
7 extracurricular classes.

8 C. Beginning with the 2015-2016 school year, the
9 legislature shall provide sufficient funds to reduce the
10 average number of students in each classroom by at least two
11 students per year until the maximum number of students per
12 classroom does not exceed the requirements of this section.
13 Until the 2020-2021 school year, the secretary of public
14 education may waive the individual school class size
15 requirements established in this section only if the school
16 district demonstrates that:

17 (1) no portable classrooms are reasonably
18 available;

19 (2) there are no available sources of funding
20 to meet the need for additional classrooms; and

21 (3) the school district is planning
22 alternatives to increase building capacity for implementation
23 within one year."

24 SECTION 2. The amendment proposed by this resolution
25 shall be submitted to the people for their approval or

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1 rejection at the next general election or at any special
2 election prior to that date that may be called for that
3 purpose.

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
