AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE ENERGY, MINERALS AND NATURAL RESOURCES DEPARTMENT FOR ENERGY AUDITS AND ALTERNATIVE ENERGY SYSTEMS AT SCHOOL DISTRICTS WITH FEWER THAN THREE HUNDRED STUDENTS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION.--

A. Ten million five hundred thousand dollars (\$10,500,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the energy, minerals and natural resources department for expenditure in fiscal years 2015 through 2017 to conduct energy audits and purchase and install appropriate alternative energy systems in the following school districts with fewer than three hundred students:
